EXHIBITORS RULES

ALL EXHIBITS ARE TO BE OPEN AND READY FOR BUSINESS BY 4 P.M.

GRANDSTAND & VARIED INSUTRY BUILDING RULES:

- 1) **Open** & ready for business Monday, July 21, at 4:00 p.m.
- 2) Open **Tuesday-Sat.** 10:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.
- 3) Open **Sunday** 12:00 – 6:00 p.m.
- 4) Tear down time Sunday night 6:00 p.m., July 27, 2008.
- 5) The **EAST DOOR of the Grandstand** and the **SOUTH DOOR of the Varied Industry Building** will be open to exhibitors **ONLY** one half hour before open to the public.
- 6) Meeting for exhibitors and awarding of trophies will be Saturday, July 26, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. in the Fair Office. We ask one representative to be present.

MACHINERY:

Set up is Saturday, July 19th or Monday, July 21st. We would like as much as possible in place by 4:00 p.m. Monday, July 21, 2008.

EXHIBITORS RESTRICTIONS:

Exhibitors must function from space assigned. **NO ONE** is permitted to roam the grounds soliciting orders for goods of any kind, donations for any cause, or distribution of food or literature.

EXHIBITORS AWARD:

The plaque for best-decorated, neat and well-attended booth will be awarded Saturday, July 26, 2008, 9:00 a.m. in the Fair Office. Coffee & doughnuts will be served. We ask at least one representative to be present for the awards & comments.

RULES: We will give **FIRST & SECOND** place awards to best booth in Commercial and Non-Commercial division

A COMMERCIAL EXHIBITOR IS: one that makes a living from their product from a place of business.

A NON-COMMERCIAL EXHIBITOR IS: one that is selling on a part time basis and does not use it as their full income. Selling from their home or flea market, etc.

JUDGES: there will be judges checking your booths throughout the day and evening, Monday, July 21, 2008 – Sunday, July 27, 2008.

CONCESSIONS & PRIVILEGES:

- 1) The Concessionaires will carefully guard against extortion in any form practiced on the patrons of the fair. A violation of this rule is to cause the forfeiture of contract, money paid and expulsion from the grounds, as the superintendent or board may direct.
- 2) The Board authorized the letting of only such privileges as are required to supply the necessary wants of the people or that may add to their comfort, convenience, and pleasure, but under no circumstances will privileges of a questionable nature be let or any manner tolerated upon the grounds or in the buildings, nor will any privilege be sold or permitted where the business is conducted in other than legitimate and trade-like manner.
- 3) All concessions shall have posted in a conspicuous manner a sign showing the price to be charged for meals, lunches, drinks or other articles of food offered for sale.
- 4) No refund will be given if cancellation is not received before June 6, 2008.
